



Who can participate:

Springbrook residents and students in Home Units are eligible. As a staff member, we encourage you to promote Springbrook's Got Talent so that residents and students may participate. If a participant needs help with a submission, please assist. If the resident or student does not have a camera or device to record themselves doing their talent, use a **Springbrook Device** and help them submit their entry!

Where to submit entries:

To participate, have the talent or skill recorded on a Springbrook device. Videos must be no longer than 2 minutes in duration and have a clean background (not cluttered or messy). Video submissions should have all residents or students shown in a dignified and presentable manner. Once completed, have your House Manager or House Assistant Manager place the video entry on the [Springbrook photo/video share drive](#), and email the **Springbrook Marketing Department** to inform that a submission has been added. Please include the name of the resident or student and what house they are from in your email.

When:

Contestants submit as many talent videos as they would like. The first season submission deadline is April 2nd. Springbrook will post episodes twice a month on Sundays once the season begins, so be sure to visit [Springbrook's Vimeo](#) to watch judges and contestant submissions and see your results!

How to earn/redeem points:

Each judge gives points on a scale of 1-10 (A max of 30 points) based on performance.
